Without Spot

1 Timothy 6:14 "That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Exactly what is Paul asking of Timothy? **Be content.**

1 Timothy 6:8 "And having food and raiment let us be therewith content."

Guard against the love of money.

1Timothy 6:9 "But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition." 10 "For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows."



We are to follow some things:

1 Timothy 6:11 "But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness."

Notice the first two: Righteousness and godliness. Someone had better explain to the preachers of

our world that the work of God is done in righteousness and godliness. Yes, there is a need for faith, love, patience and meekness; but the first two qualities mentioned are righteousness and godliness. Someone ought to be shouting from the housetops, "Be holy!"

Paul did not leave any room for failure. Paul directed Timothy;

"That thou keep this commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Those are not merely ideas, thoughts, or proverbial obscurities: they are commands from God to those He places into the office of pastor!
